What is International Night?

Ben-Hem's 9th annual International night is an opportunity for students to become an expert on a particular country and to "visit" the countries shared by their fellow Bobcats.

Students pick a country that they don't know much about or share the culture and traditions of a country that has to do with their family's heritage. They research that country and then create a display of their discoveries in the Ben-Hem cafetorium on January 24th. They may use visual displays, props, pictures, maps, flags, or foreign currency to share their knowledge. They may come dressed in clothing that represents their country. They should be ready to talk about their country to visitors that view their display.

Who can participate?

Students in grades K-4 are welcome.

When is International Night?

Participants will arrive at 6:30 pm on January 24th to set up their table. Visitors are invited from 7-8 pm to see the display of countries. On the evening of the event, visitors will be given a Ben-Hem Passport to be stamped by each country they visit in the cafetorium.
