All preschool and elementary age students in the town of Natick. Group submissions will also be accepted from classrooms, scout troops, church groups, etc.

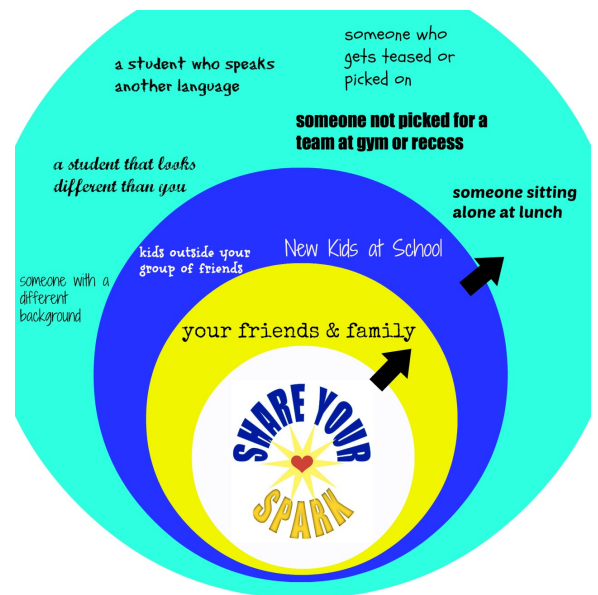
#### ***Exhibition of All Entries and Selection of Winners:***
