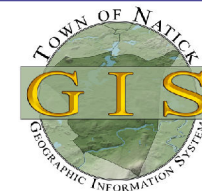




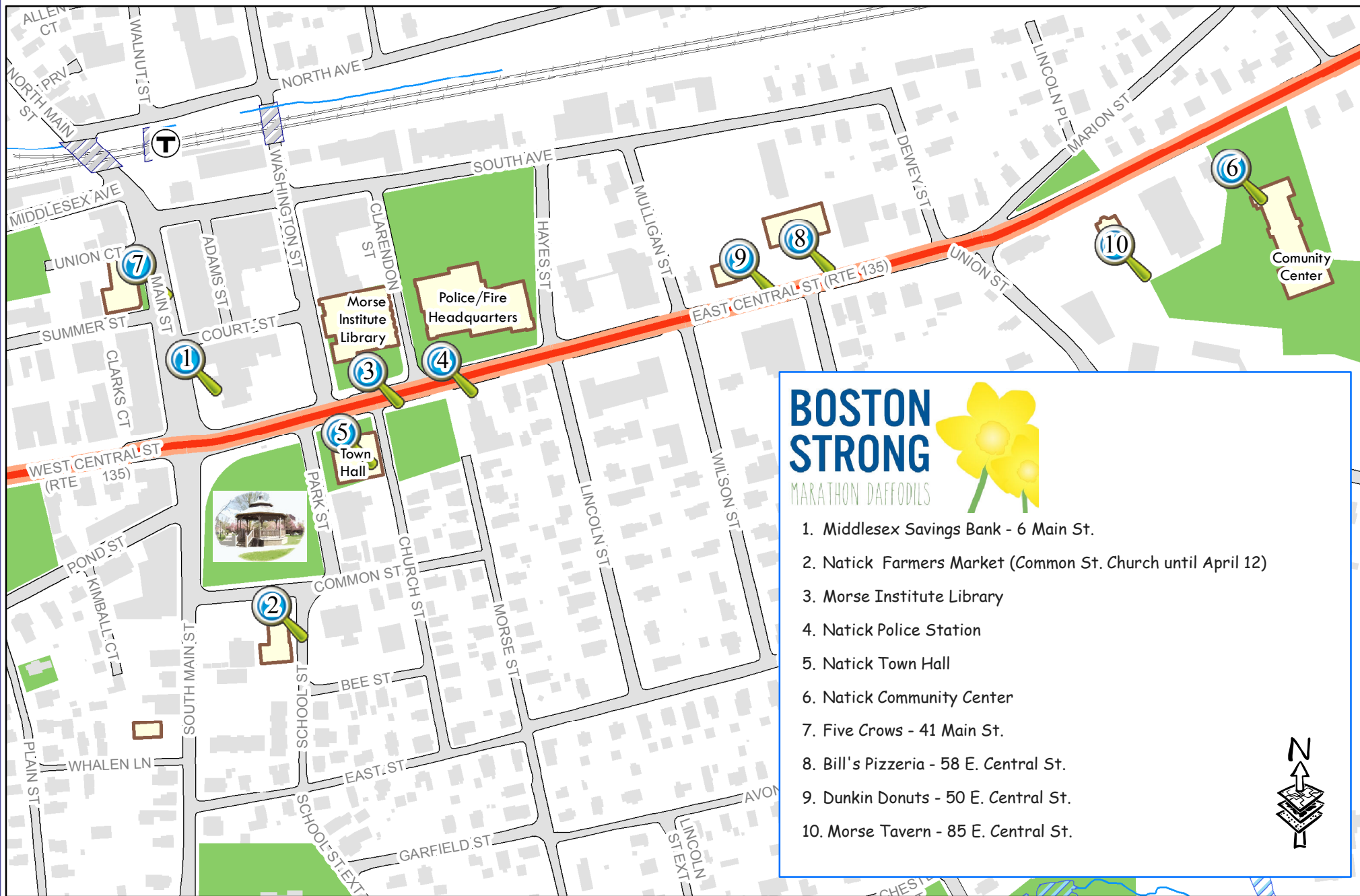
Daffodil Detective Map
